The 5 children are all now in secondary Nakasi Deborah S.3, Lwanga Sam S.4, Nalubega S.3, Nakazibwe Angelina S.2 and Nakiryowa Phiona S.3. By the time of intervention by MCSI and WVU, these children were still very young and had lost their parents.

They have grown and are now in secondary school in S.2, S.3 and S.4. Their future is now secured that they have attained basic education. The sponsors give them food and school dues. Thank you Mr. Alle Jan and Mathanel for this support, May the Lord the King of Heaven and Earth bless you abundantly.

You have also relieved me from the pressure that have managed to complete my house and have also set up a lower primary school building block just next to my house for the little children I teach because previously I was teaching them from my sitting room.
