We did not get justice from the courts in Uganda because my mother was helpless and the trailer was for a big company in Kenya. We were left in a rental house with no support, we starved with no accommodation and our mother could take us to clean rich peoples compounds for just food because payment was very little for school.

I will never forget the day we did not get a meal and in the morning my mother went to Aunt Vicky to wash her clothes for some money so as to buy us something to eat, we were left home with cries from my young ones because of hunger. Unfortunately the mother did not come back with anything to eat that she was not paid because it rained and the clothes did not dry, so she did not qualify for payment.



I will never forget the day when **Uncle Ssozi Abbey** and a white man (**Alle Jan**) visited our small room in the suburb of Mukono town and told my mother that they are willing to help me with school fees.



In response my mother started crying but this was because of happiness. I was in Primary five at the age of 10 by then and through **Mukono Child Support** I was able to finish primary level and Ordinary Secondary Level and passed in Grade one. I finished Ordinary level Education and enrolled for a two year course in Lower Primary Education supported by Government because I passed well. After the course I got a job in Saudi Arabia teaching English and am now earning a living but all this success is because of **Mukono Child Support Initiative**. I pay School Dues for my young ones and accommodation for my mother because she is helpless. I plan to build a house for my family because my mother is helpless.
